Dear Director,

On behalf of the Pasadena Independent School District, I want to welcome you and your choir to the 2004 Region XIX UIL Middle School Vocal Concert and Sight-Reading Contest, Tuesday, April 6, Wednesday, April 7, and Thursday, April 8. We hope to run a smooth contest. Please be sure to familiarize your students with the locations and the rules. You will find the directions on the PMHS website and a map of our building on the UIL website.

Please assemble in our Gym ten minutes before your warm-up time. We will have one warm-up room. Each choir will be allowed **fifteen minutes** in warm-up with **five minutes** traveling time to the stage. If you are late to warm-up, you will not receive your fifteen minutes. In order to keep the contest flowing smoothly we will stick strictly to the schedule. The monitors will be instructed to move you from the choir room to the stage five minutes before your performance time.

Please be advised of the following rules:

- 1. No one will be allowed into the auditorium once a choir has entered the stage. Audience members will sit in the back of the auditorium, behind the judges, during the performance. Please be aware that choirs may not sit in the auditorium all day. Plan on listening to a few choirs, and then move your students out to the gym so that others may have a turn.
- 2. A director or sponsor must supervise the students at all times.
- 3. Misbehavior in the audience will not be tolerated. We want each choir to have ideal performing conditions.
- 4. No tape recorders, radios, CD players, headsets, cell phones or pagers will be allowed at the contest site.
- 5. The student holding area is in the gym. Students will sit in the bleachers. They are NOT TO WALK ON THE GYM FLOOR WITH HARD-SOLED SHOES. There will be no food, drinks, candy or gum allowed in the gym.

6. We will have a concession stand available to your students. Please tell your students to purchase snacks and drinks at the concession stand in the hallway. We will have tables there where students may eat and drink items they have purchased. However: **there must be no food**, **drinks, candy, gum allowed in the gym or auditorium at anytime.**

Director's Information

- 1. Please drop students off at the gym entrance on the the west side of the campus. Students will enter through the west doors and go directly into the gym to be seated. Buses may be parked in the student parking area on the west side of the campus on the back rows by the tennis courts or practice fields.
- 2. Results will be posted on the wall by the entry/exit doors on the west side of the campus.
- 3. Please keep your students in the gym or the auditorium while you are not in the competition process.
- 4. There will be eight three-step risers in all areas.
- 5. Remember to bring your completed **Form #1** to the Contest Office (our Box Office) when you arrive.
