Dear Director,

On behalf of Webster Intermediate School, I welcome you to the Region XIX Middle School Orchestra Concert and Sight-Reading Contest. The contest will be held Monday, March 29, and Tuesday, March 30, 2004.

Upon arrival, each director should check-in at the contest office located in the first hallway. The door to that hallway can be found directly across the breezeway from the front auditorium entrance. A sign will be posted. Be prepared to leave your judges scores and **FORM 1**. Please be sure to have **all measures numbered** and have your school name on the front of every score.

Buses should be unloaded in front of the auditorium. After unloading, please direct the buses to park in the lot at the other end of the campus. A monitor will meet your group at the unloading area. He or she will direct you to the cafeteria where instrument cases can be stored. You must provide your own monitor to watch the cases; **the cafeteria is not a secure area**.

When it is time, you will be directed to the choir room for warm-up. A metronome and tuner will be available in the warm-up room. Please remind your students to move quietly from one area to the next. A monitor will tell you when it is time to leave warm-up. This will be five minutes prior to your stage performance time. Please be courteous and leave at the appointed time so that the next group can enter and the contest can remain on schedule.

We will set the stage as per your instructions. It is a good idea to send a representative from your school to assist with set-up so that we are sure the stage is set exactly as you want it. The curtains will remain open at all times.

Sight-reading will take place in the band room. It is located directly behind the stage. Because of possible violation of the copyright law, and to uphold the integrity of the contest, no audio recording or videotaping in the sight-reading room is allowed. Please inform your parents of this. It would be better if they hear it from you than from a judge.

There will be no concession stand. Restrooms are located in the front of the auditorium. Please provide a monitor to escort children to the restrooms to insure that they remain quiet in this area. We ask that students not be allowed in the main building, as regular classes will be in session. Please remind students and parents not to enter the auditorium while a group is performing.

Comment sheets may be picked up in the contest office thirty minutes after sight-reading.

Do not hesitate to call or e-mail if there is anything we can do to help you with this contest.
