The administration, staff, students and parents of Atascocita High School welcome you to our campus for this year's Region 19 U.I.L. High School Orchestra Solo and Ensemble Contest on Saturday, February 6, 2016. We are very excited to be hosting this event and hope that you and your students will enjoy being with us.

Please review these guidelines in advance of the contest:

- 1.) Upon arrival directors should check in at the contest office located in the medium ensemble room of the fine arts wing.
- 2.) Please have your Form 1 completed and ready when checking in.
- 3.) Please double-check your entries and submit all entry changes to Ben Gollehon in advance of the day of the contest.
- 4.) Please be certain that all judging materials are originals, the correct edition, and have numbered measures.
- 5.) Review your scheduled adjudication times and locations with students and be sure that they are present, prompt, and prepared.
- 6.) Remind students that their class one solo must be performed from memory to qualify for the Texas State Solo & Ensemble contest.
- 7.) When entering the Atascocita High School campus, please use the bus entrance from West Lake Houston Parkway. Drivers are permitted to park in the available lot behind the school. Contest participants should enter the school through the cafeteria entrance at the back of the building. Visible signs will be posted on this door.
- 8.) Students are permitted to use the cafeteria only as a place for storing cases, warm-up, and refreshments. Please encourage your students to bring funds for the available concessions and remind them that food and drinks should be kept only in the cafeteria.
- 9.) Please monitor your students, being certain that they are quiet in the areas outside of contest rooms. A.H.S volunteers will be present to assist students and directors with finding their performance locations and monitoring student behavior.

Directors should develop a solo and ensemble performance schedule according to the times provided for your school by the U.I.L. Region 19 Executive Secretary. Please plan to follow this schedule and resolve any conflicts with your students, another school, or contact Ben Gollehon.
