Dear Director.

We would like to welcome you to North Shore High School for the Region XIX UIL Music South Zone CC/CCC Middle School Concert and Sight-Reading Contest to be held on Thursday, April 1, and Friday, April 2, 2004.

Please be advised of the following rules:

- 1. No one will be allowed into the auditorium once a band has entered the stage. Audience members will sit in the back of the auditorium, behind the judges, during the performance.
- 2. A director or sponsor must supervise the students at all times.
- 3. Misbehavior in the audience will not be tolerated. We want each band to have ideal performing conditions.
- 4. No tape recorders, radios, CD players, headsets, cell phones, or pagers will be allowed at the contest site.
- 5. The student holding area is in the food court (cafeteria). Remember that we have lunches from 10:45 until 12:45 so try to limit the number of seats you use during those hours. There will be no food, drinks, candy, or gum allowed in the auditorium at anytime.

A student monitor will meet your band when you arrive and will remain with your band throughout the entire contest procedure. Please be courteous and cooperate with them so the contest will run on schedule.

Buses should park in the student parking lot as designated on the map. A student monitor will guide you to the warm-up room. Your equipment truck will unload and load behind the band hall as designated on the map. The equipment truck must immediately move after unloading and loading and park in the student parking lot with your buses. Please make your bus drivers aware of where this area is located.

There will **NOT** be an area for the storage of instrument cases. All cases should be stored on the buses.

A stage set-up crew will be provided, but an assistant director's help will be appreciated. The set-up crew will do their best to accommodate your exact set-up requirements. The set-up crew will begin each set-up at the curtain line. Risers will be provided on stage.

The doors to the auditorium will remain closed while a band is performing and will be opened only between performances. In order to maintain a comfortable temperature on stage, the house temperature may be colder than normal.

Directors should check in at the contest office as soon as possible upon arrival. Remember to have your scores numbered and your school's name written on each score. Make sure your Form #1 is accurate and signed by your administrator.

Warm-up will be in the choir room. Your monitor will notify you when it is time to leave the warm-up room for the stage; this will be five (5) minutes before your performance time. You must leave at the appointed time so that the contest remains on schedule. Please be courteous to the monitor.

After your concert performance, you student monitor will take you to the sight-reading area, which is located in the band hall. The monitors will also set up chairs and stands to match the set-up used for your concert performance. Risers will not be used in the sight-reading room.

Equipment needed in the sight-reading room:

Level II – Varsity Bells,

(CC) Crash Cymbals,

Snare Drum, Bass Drum

Level III – varsity Bells

(CCC) Snare Drum, Bass Drum

Triangle, Suspended Cymbal,

Crash Cymbal

Equipment provided in the sight-reading room:

a. Bass Drum d. Orchestra Bells

b. Timpanic. Chimes

You will need to provide all other instruments necessary for sight-reading such as snare drum, crash cymbals, suspended cymbal, triangle, etc. Drumsticks, mallets, and other accessories will not be provided.

Band students may wait for their ratings in the cafeteria area. Students should not be left unsupervised.

A concession stand will available in the cafeteria area after 1:00 p.m.


