Clarification... as indicated on the Set-Up Chart, we have 3, 8" risers and 3, 16" risers only. Please indicate on the representation of your ensemble the amount of each you will be using and how. This is best indicated with rectangles and the chairs and stands within the rectangle.**

I. Judges Scores

Please have three (3) original scores for each of your selections. **All scores should be numbered with your school name on the front of each score.** Your monitor will bring the scores to the auditorium. We will make every attempt to return your scores after the sightreading...please don't leave without them.

II. Equipment – L.D. Bell will be furnishing this equipment ONLY. No other percussion equipment or implements of any kind will be supplied... even if you can see it in an office or equipment room.

VI. Unloading and Loading

Buses will enter the parking lot from Brown Trail, the Southeast parking lot entrance. School will be in session, so the cafeteria will not be available as a holding area. A monitor will be present to bring your ensemble upstairs to wait single file for the warm-up room to become available.

- We will not be able to furnish mallets, sticks, beaters, cymbals, snare drums, or any other accessories.
- We will provide a Node chromatic tuner and McAdams metronome in the Warm-up Room. You may bring your own.
