**I. Schedule**

Enclosed you will find the schedule for the Region V UIL Concert & Sightreading Contest. Please be prepared to follow the times listed. A monitor will meet your buses at the unloading area to escort you to the warm-up room.

We will provide a set-up crew for the stage so you should only have to make minor adjustments. **Please email or fax the set-up chart to 817-375-6705 no later than Monday, March 31, 2007.**

**II. Contest Office**

A monitor will escort you to the contest office upon arrival for check in. Ratings will be posted near the contest office. A director may pick up packets containing comment sheets, scores, and trophies as soon as results are posted. Please verify you have everything before you leave.

**III. Judges Scores**

Please have three (3) original scores for each of your selections. **Please clearly write the name of your school on each score. Make sure all measures are numbered.** We will collect the scores when you check in at the contest office.

**IV. Equipment**

Seguin HS will furnish the following:

*Concert Stage*

Chimes	Bells

(Snare drums, cymbals, and any accessories must be brought with you. Seguin HS will not be able to furnish these items.)

*Sightreading Room*

All Equipment provided (bring your own sticks, mallets, & beaters)

Level I Non-Varsity - 2C, 3C

Snare Drum/Bass Drum, Crash Cymbals/Triangle, Bells

Level II Varsity - 2C

Snare Drum/Bass Drum, Triangle, Bells or Xylophone

Level III Varsity - 3C

Snare Drum/Bass Drum, Bells, Susp. Cymbal/Triangle

**V. Food**

No eating facilities are available on campus.

**VI. Dressing**

We are unable to furnish dressing rooms. Plan to arrive and depart in uniform.

**VII. Storage**

Storage areas for instrument cases will not be provided. Please use buses for storage.

**VIII. Important Reminders**

- We must keep the contest on schedule. Please be ready to move when asked.
- We will not furnish mallets, sticks, beaters, cymbals, snare drums, or any other accessories for the concert stage or sightreading room.
- We will provide a Node chromatic tuner and McAdams metronome in the Warm-up Room. You may bring your own.

**You must have a Form 1 and/or addendum on file for all contestants entered.** This must be done before the first unit performs. Failure to follow UIL guidelines and procedures outlined in the PML and C&CR will result in action taken by the University Interscholastic League.
