When arriving at Birdville High, please have your buses enter the east (stadium side) parking lot. The bus can drop you off next to the auditorium and then park at the far-east end of the lot. Since this contest is taking place during school hours, we ask that you do not let your students advance into the main portion of the school. If you would please, keep your students in the auditorium, foyer, or outside. This will allow for a smooth contest and prevent any unwarranted situation.

The contest set up is as follows:

Warm-up room – Dance Studio (7 sections of 3 step risers, studio piano)

Concert – Auditorium (7 sections of 4 step risers, grand piano, 7 shells)

Sight-reading room – Choir room (Wenger built-in chair risers, 4 rows counting the floor)
